EXAMINATIONS

Exams for 1 kyu and 1-3 dan will take place after the Championships on August 21, 2010.

Examinations fees according to the Polish Kendo Association pricelist.

The enrollment application for the exam should include :

Name and surname, date of birth, rank held at present, date and venue of previous exam, name of parent club, name and surname of instructor.

The enrolment application is to be submitted by e-mail or by post at the following addresses – exams@iaido.org.pl or - Polskie Stowarzyszenie Iaido, 45-311 Opole, ul.Kujawska 8 within the deadline by July 30, 2010.

Application forms containing incomplete information or submitted after the enrolment deadline will not be accepted.

INDYWIDUAL INTERNATIONAL IAIDO CHAMPIONCHIPS (mudan, shodan, nidan, sandan)

Only the members of the clubs affiliated to the Polish Kendo Association or participants from abroad affiliated to the European Kendo Federation via their country are allowed to submit their participation forms.

Championships participation fee – 5 PLN (1 EUR). Payable directly on the spot.

The forms should be submitted by e-mail **by July 30, 2010 at the latest.** (mail to: taikai@iaido.org.pl) or by letter – Polskie Stowarzyszenie Iaido, , ul. Kujawska 8, 45-311, Opole, Poland.

Incomplete forms or forms submitted after the submission deadline will not be accepted.

The participation form should include:

Name and surname, date of birth, iaido rank, name of the club and the instructor

Attire and equipment:

During the championships the iaido attire is obligatory with the club badge (zekken) sewn on the left breast side.

Only the use of iaito is allowed. The sageo is obligatory in all categories (mudan, shodan, nidan, sandan).

Qualifying round (cup tournament)



During the qualifying rounds there will be 3 katas (in 4 minutes) fixed by the Committee of Referees before the competition.

Depending on the number of participants three groups having from 3 to 4 people will be formed. Two people from each group with the highest number of flags will enter the final round.

Finals (knock-out tournament)

During finals there will be 5 obligatory katas (in 6 minutes) determined by the Committee of Referees.

The first, the second and the two third places will be awarded in the final round.

In case there are too few participants in a category making it impossible to form an elimination group, the rules of determining the winners will be established following the ultimate deadline of submission of participation forms for the competition.

CAUTION: Participants who do not have their valid health certificates are not allowed to take part in the competition.
